Details

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The interior layout offers an owner's suite with head and separate shower, two guest's cabins, two guest's heads and a crew cabin in the forepeak with direct access from deck. The U shape galley is located next to the companionway on the port side, opposite to a large chart table and an large oilskins locker.

Great care has been given to weight distribution, the installation of all mechanical and electrical equipment (power generator, air-conditioning, water-maker..) as well as to their housing for easy use and maintenance.
