DÜSSELDORF WORLD PREMIERE: Greenline 48 Hybrid Solar

The development culmination of the past five years is now brought together in the flagship of the range, the Greenline 48 Hybrid Solar.

The latest and best from the Greenline range is the next green innovation that will complement the current range of Greenline 33 and 40 while presenting new features:

- New interior style
- 3rd generation Hybrid system
- Comfortable flybridge
- Two guest cabins
- Hydraulic platform
- Utility compartment under salon

With the novelties she will present a sophisticated bridge between the Greenline's SeaClass (range up to 50 feet) and OceanClass (range beyond 50 feet).

The first boat in the range to bring the amenities of a flybridge, the 48 will open new horizons to her users. Not only will she pamper her guests with perfect comfort, she will be on a technologically different level from her competition. Solar panels on the roof charge lithium batteries, which power two 14 kilowatt electric motors / 10 kW generators, making purely electric sailing possible.

The interior has been designed with a new level of comfort, practicality and vision in mind. The cockpit, galley and salon communicate seamlessly on one level, eliminating clumsy corners and facilitating movement around the boat.

Like the rest of the yacht, the salon includes 220V home appliances that will create the feel of home.

Greenline 40 - with a new White Oak interior design

For the 2014 season, the Greenline 40 series has profited from a completely fresh interior design, descending from the new flagship of the range, the Greenline 48 Hybrid. The new White Oak interior has been designed by Johana Kriznic, Seaway's in-house Italian-Slovenian architect and interior designer.

Renderings of the Greenline 48 present the designed interior that shall be applied to the Greenline 40:



Ms. Kriznic shares her insight: *"The new White Oak interior design reflects the philosophy of the yard with a 'clear' look into the future.... A lots of very simple lines, white washed oak and light fabrics. Linearity and simplicity are the concepts behind the design of the interior and individual elements. It will enable a new level of well-being on the 40 by*

giving the feeling of a large, open and warm space. With the use of new materials and colors I believe we have achieved a totally new interior emotion."

Johana is also in charge of designing the other sister brands. At the OceanClass hybrid yachts she had a privilege to work with one of the most famous designers in yacht design industry – Rhoades Young Design. She also designed over 10 Shipman carbon yachts and had a great experience cooperating with famous sailing boat designer Harry Miesbauer during the Shipman 72 project.

Johana lives in Trieste and works in Slovenia. Since her childhood she has found a passion for design and sailing. An avid sailor already in her early years, she has raced in different international one design classes as Optimist, Europa and 420. Today, after her work she loves to spend some time on the sailing boat and participate at the local regattas over the weekends.
