

Pursuit 2670 Denali LS

Dubbed a “modern classic” by Pursuit, the 2670 comes with a forward center helm configuration, a design the company has never offered before. But the new boat also boasts the angler amenities typical of all Pursuits, including tackle and rod storage, a livewell and a macerated in-floor fishbox. The company is betting the 2670 will reel in boaters who are hungry for a pleasurecraft—not just a vessel that will help them catch fish.

“The popularity of today’s SUVs let us know that boaters are looking for more versatility,” says Pursuit founder Leon Slikkers, who designed the boat. “I feel [the 2670] will create many new trends in the industry.”

To add cabin space and create an open-air galley, the boat comes with a stovetop that slides out from under the double-wide helm seat. There’s also a fold-out sun lounge, drink holders, and port and starboard storage bins on deck. The modest cabin area was designed to be unobtrusive to fishing activities while adding room for the V-berth.

Hydraulic steering and an aluminum steering wheel come standard. You’ll also find a transom door with aluminum grabrails, an 18-gallon freshwater tank and two aluminum fuel tanks. The cabin is available with optional teak detailing and striped fabric. The 2670 even comes with four PFDs.
