With it began a long, cooperative partnership between Hanse Yachts and the world's leading naval architects judel/vrolijk & co. "The" new Hanse 385 is a logical development and builds up on the success of the 445, 495 and 545 models.

EXTERIOR AND HULL DESIGN

The Hanse 385 has more interior volume with improved sailing performance. The deck is free of fittings, the anchor box takes fenders. The large cockpit has comfortable seating positions and a multifunctional new designed cockpit table. There is plenty of room for a standard double wheel system with a broad cross on the bathing platform. Including concealed storage space for life raft and gas bottle.

INTERIOR DESIGN

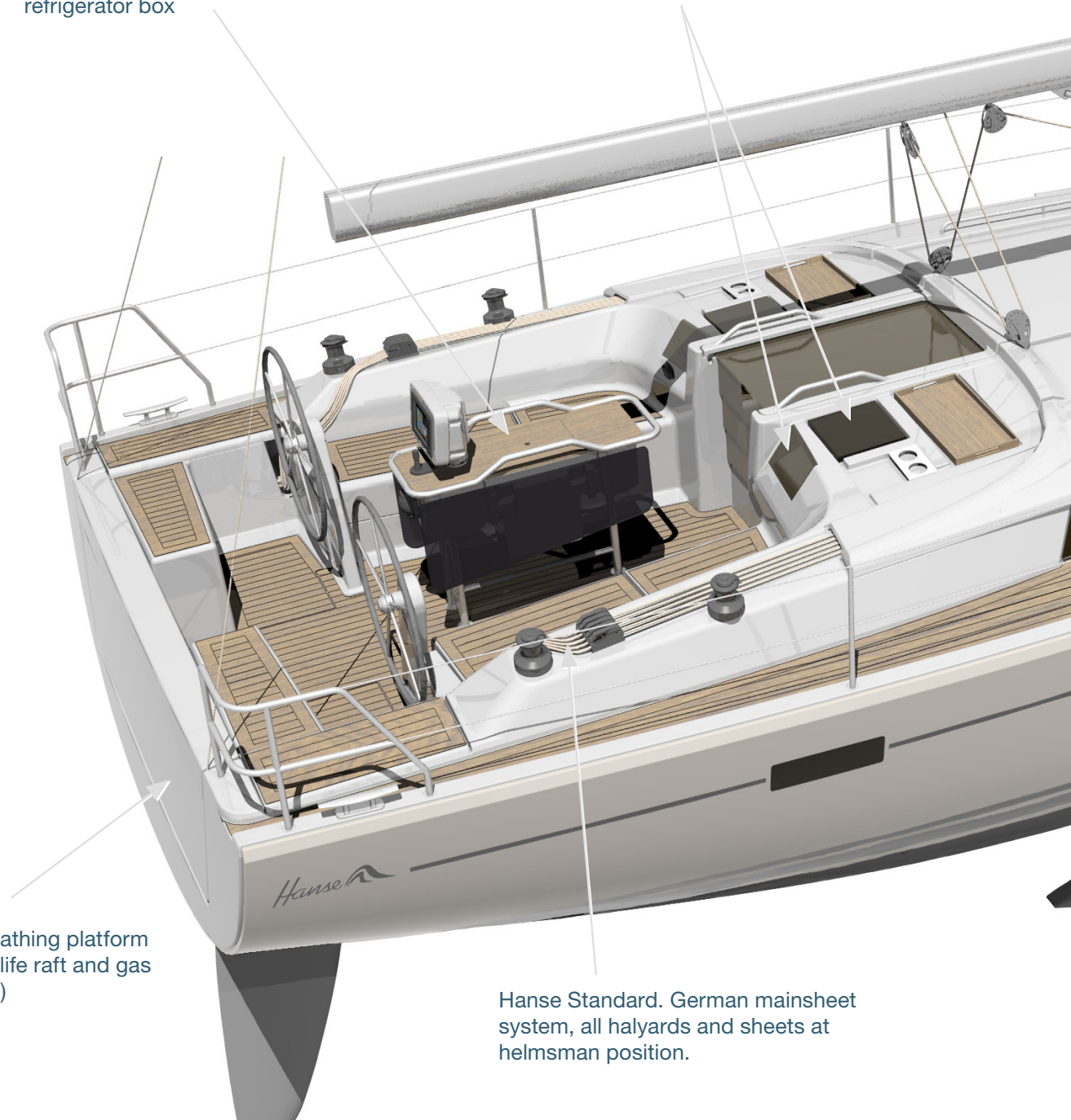
The interior concept is based on the larger loft style Hanse models. Our goal was to develop contemporary furniture design and an intelligent extension of the living space. For example the length and height of the owner's cabin in the bow with much freedom of movement. The voluminous L-shape-galley which will become the benchmark in the 38-foot class. This also applies to the lighting and ventilation system. Above the owners cabin there are two full-size flush hatches and the head and galley have large flush hatches and extra large cockpit portlights.

New designed multifunctional cockpit table with compass and stowage. As option: chart plotter, refrigerator box

Fresh air supply and light through flush hatches and cockpit portlights for galley/head

Large folding bathing platform with access to life raft and gas bottle (optional)
