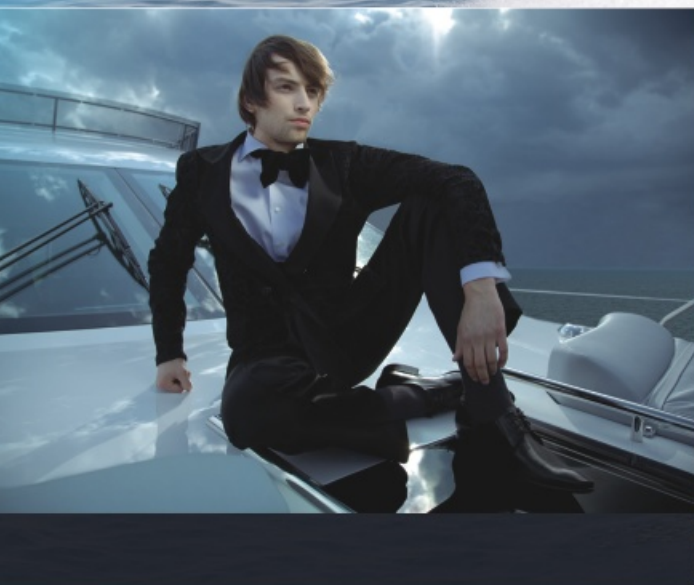

With a top speed of 32 knots when powered by two standard MAN engines (1100 HP each) it can keep up with much smaller sport cruisers. The optional 1360 HP engines turn it into a high performance vessel capable of 36 knots. Either engine option is guaranteed to make a big impression when on the water.

The Opacmare Transformer Platform is an option you don't want to miss out on. Mounted on the stern it serves as a gangway, swim ladder, tender lift and a loading stage. When horizontal it triples in size and serves as an extension of the platform. 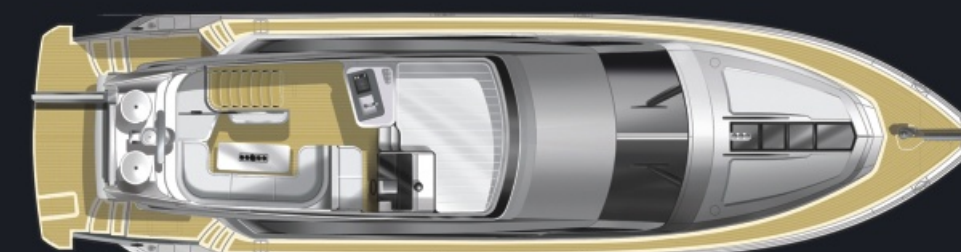

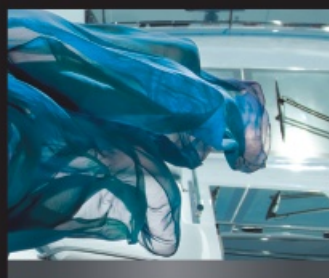
