Impact is compact. Making it ideal as a tender that can be easily stowed.



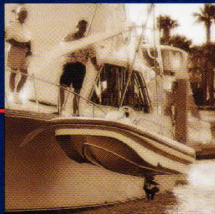

Boston Whaler's innovative Impact has all of the advantages of an inflatable tender without the disadvantages. It's stable. Non-marring. Soft sided. But in contrast to an inflatable, the Impact won't deflate.

The technology behind the unique Impact Collar System (ICS) starts with an outer sleeve of durable polyurethane. This material is five times more abrasion resistant and two times more puncture resistant than hypalon – the material used to construct most high-end inflatables. The sleeve is filled with closed-cell foam which provides cushion upon impact and additional flotation.

A small polyurethane bladder at the core of the collar is the only air-filled component. Its primary purpose is cosmetic: when inflated, the bladder causes the material of the exterior sleeve to tighten for a smoother finish. However, even when the bladder is completely deflated, the collar retains its shape and functionality.

The bladder's secondary function is as a pneumatic shock absorber for even greater impact cushioning.
