

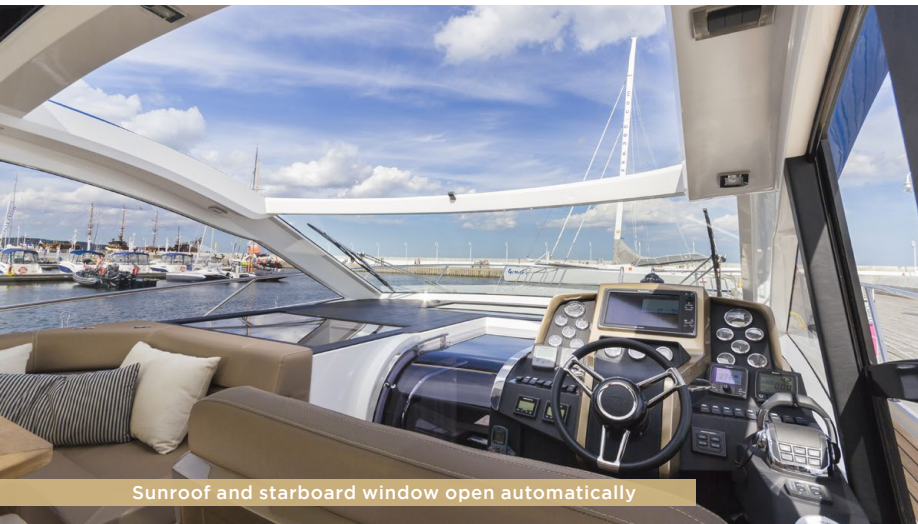

The 445 HTS is another of Galeon's third-generation models with brilliant, eye-catching design. This open-deck sport model – similar in design to Galeon's 325 and 385 yachts – offers a dynamic ride for thrill-seekers who are also looking for a yacht that is manageable and provides plenty of comfort.

The 445 allows for an abundance of natural light to penetrate into the interior, with a large, glass ceiling over the helm station and ample skylights in the bow cabin.

Comfort and convenience have not been neglected: The master cabin boasts an en-suite bathroom, and there is plenty of room in the large hydraulic garage for personal watercraft like a Jet Ski or even a Jet RIB. On top, find a spacious sundeck.

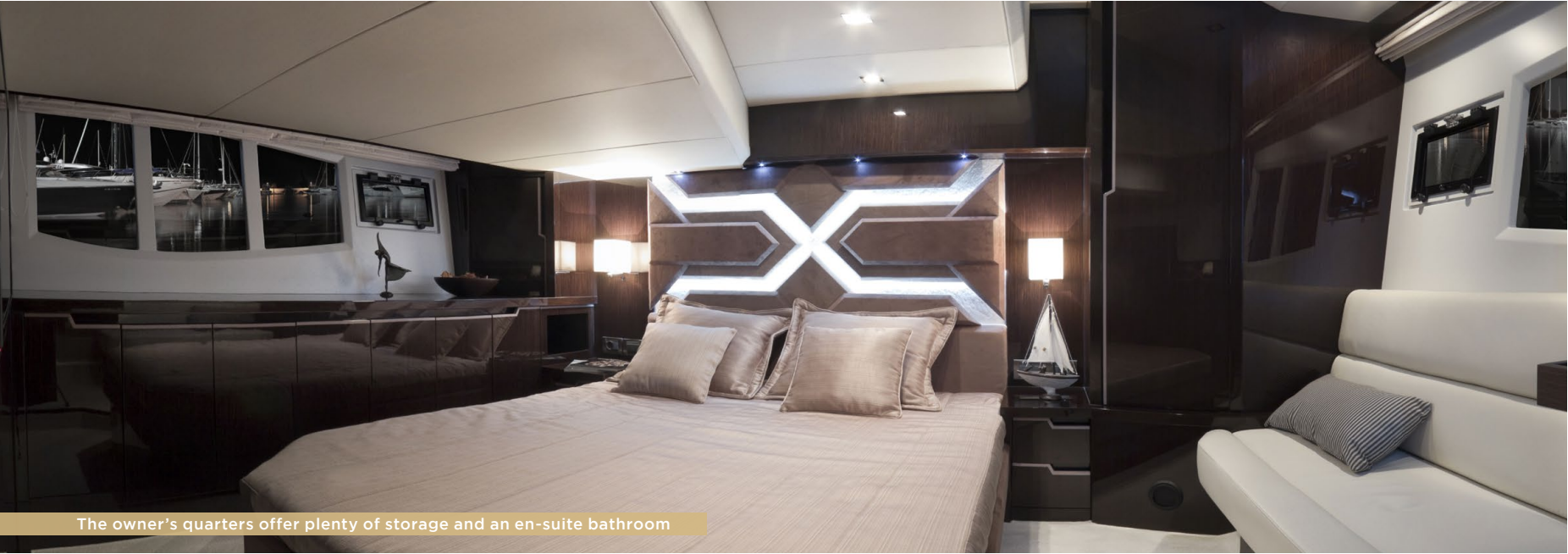

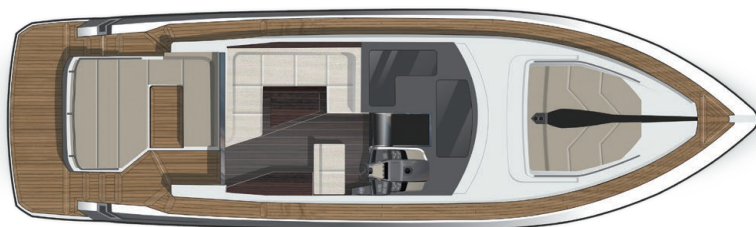
