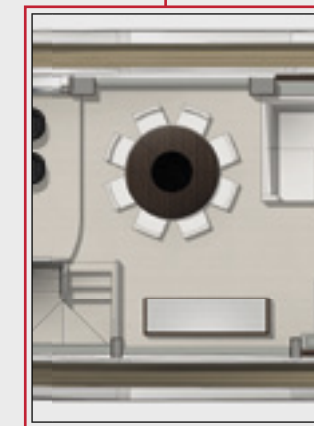
SIDE PROFILE
