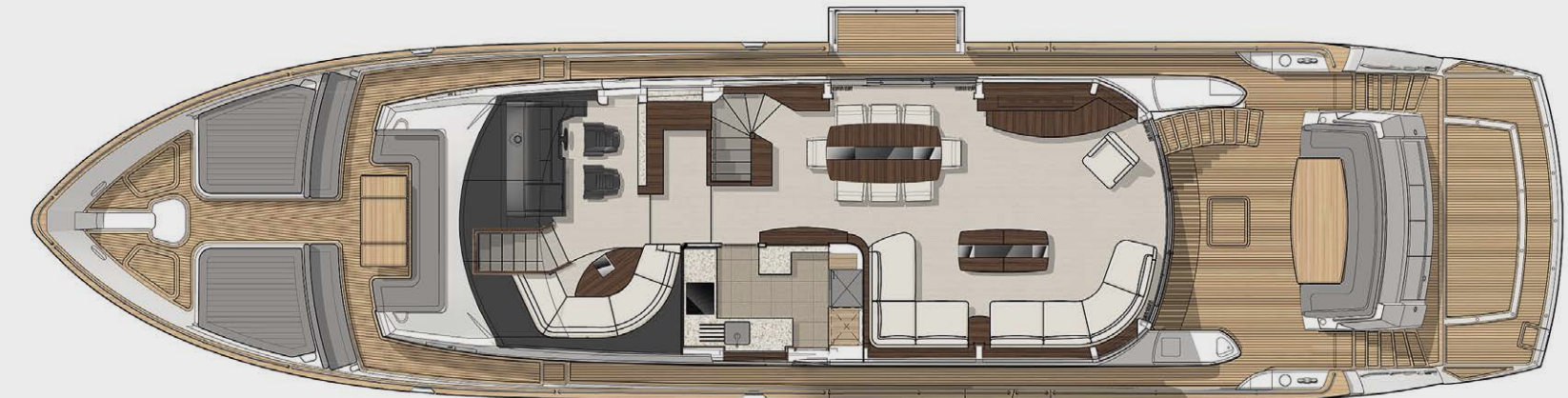

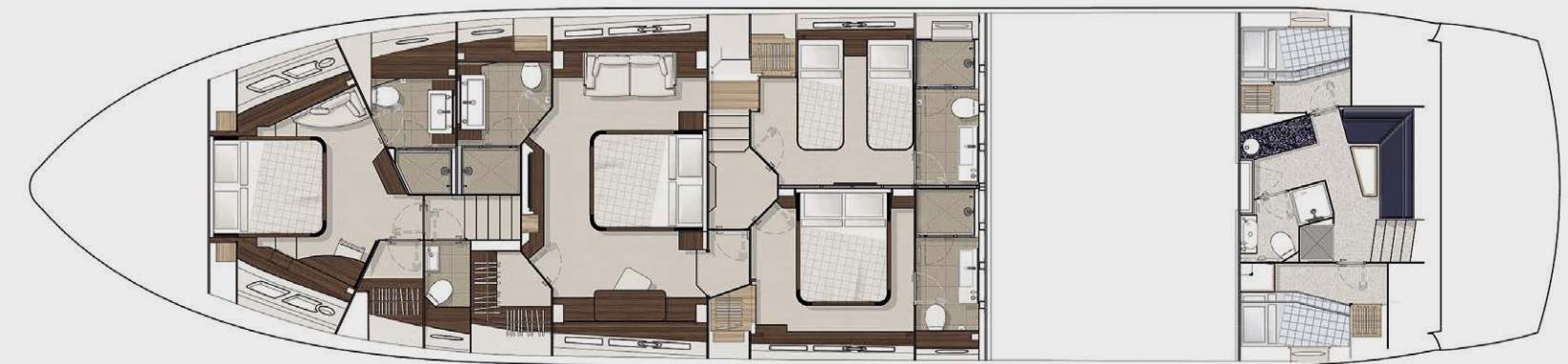
SIDE PROFILE
