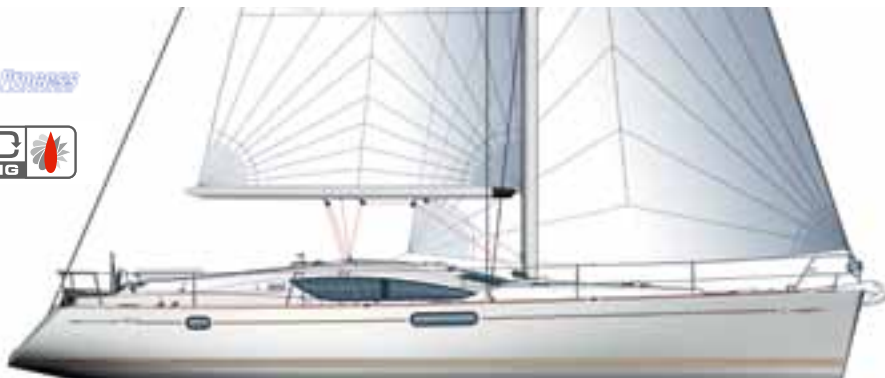

KEY POINTS

- Exceptional style and comfort:
 - Innovative design by Philippe Briand combining comfort and functionality
 - Spacious cockpit with modern deck lines by Garroni Design
- Light and space created by the Deck Saloon concept:
 - Very light interior thanks to deck house windows and large hull ports
 - The owner's cabin can be forward to aft, depending on each owner's taste
- Impressive list of standard equipment:
 - Furling mainsail, long Harken mainsheet traveller, double stainless steel anchor roller and powerful windlass
 - Forward sail locker and dedicated compartment for the liferaft in the transom
 - Special spaces designed to hold optional equipment: generator, washer/dryer, etc...

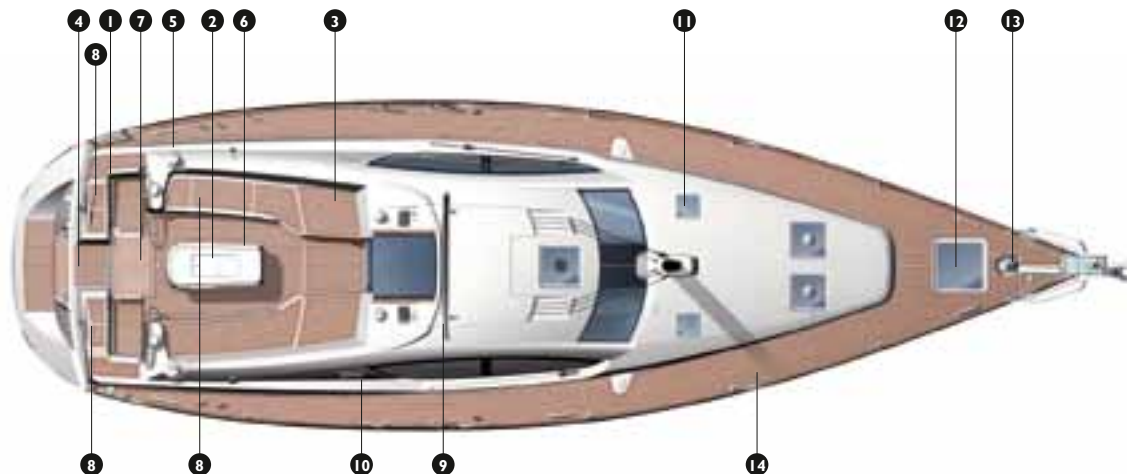

DECK PLAN

A comfortable and spacious cockpit with 3 separate areas :

► Deck

- 1 Helm area with electronic displays, engine controls and access to primary winches
- 2 Dining area with large table and seating for 6
- 3 Lounge area forward for relaxing
- 4 Dedicated space for liferaft storage with easy access
- 5 Harken winches located near helm stations (electric winches optional)
- 6 Domed ceiling in aft cabins with opening ports extends under the cockpit table and provides headroom, ventilation and light
- 7 Additional storage area under grating in the cockpit floor
- 8 3 large cockpit lockers
- 9 Long Harken traveller
- 10 Opening coachroof ports hidden behind fibreglass grills
- 11 Numerous deck hatches for ventilation
- 12 Deep forward storage locker with access ladder
- 13 Powerful anchor windlass and double anchor rollers
- 14 Hull and deck construction certified by Bureau Veritas



INTERIOR DESIGN

- 1 Contemporary interior design in Fine Teak with new satin varnish
- 2 Laminate floorboards
- 3 Light head liner material used on ceiling and along hull sides to create the maximum feeling of space and light
- 4 Handrails along under fixed windows and along the ceiling
- 5 Leather-wrapped handrails placed along nav station and companionway
- 6 Storage cabinets all along either side of the saloon
- 7 Indirect lighting for cosy atmosphere
- 8 Compression post encased in stylish wood enclosure
- 9 Optional lounge chairs increase seating capacity and flexibility
- 10 Oversized hull ports provide excellent visibility from the saloon
- 11 Deck Saloon windows with pleated pull-down shades for privacy
- 12 All overhead hatches with pleated insect screens and shades

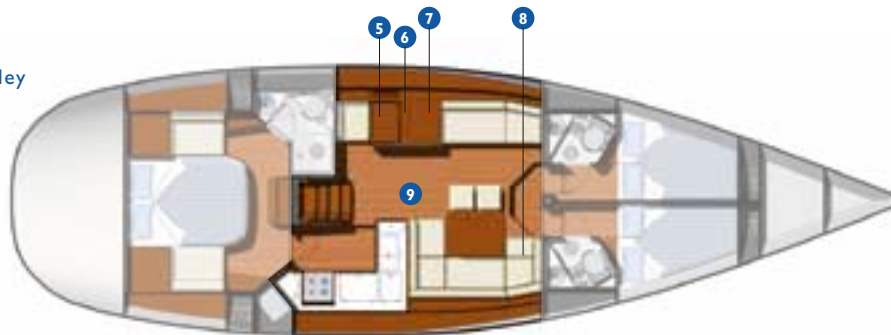
► Interior Design



INTERIOR LAYOUT

- ❶ L-galley design solid surface countertops
- ❷ Dedicated spot for optional microwave oven
- ❸ Fridge compartment 175L with top access and optional stainless steel front access
- ❹ Freezer compartment 80L with top access and optional 12V compressor
- ❺ Navigation desk with roll-away top to facilitate use of a laptop computer
- ❻ Leather-lined pen holder
- ❼ Large storage cabinet houses bar furnishings or optional technical equipment
- ❽ Stylish seating around large table
- ❾ Storage bins under floor

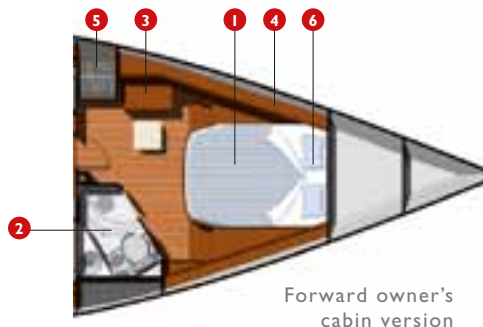

FORWARD CABIN: 2 VERSIONS

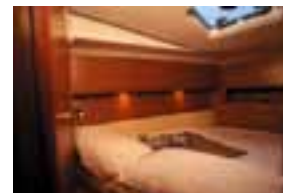
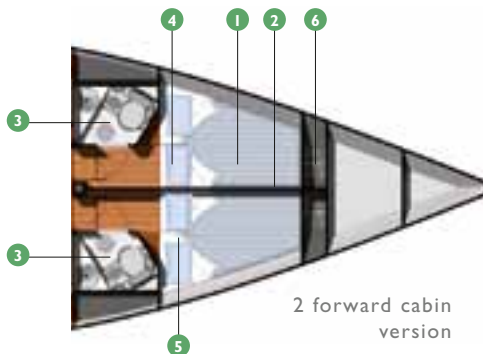
- ❶ Large island berth (2,05m x 1,63m) with PREMIUM mattress
- ❷ Large owner's head with separate shower with plexiglass door
- ❸ Vanity area with seat, desk and storage
- ❹ Upper storage cabinets along the hull sides with indirect lighting underneath
- ❺ Large hanging locker
- ❻ Lined headboard at forward end of berth

► Forward owner's cabin



- ❶ 2 double berths with PREMIUM mattresses
- ❷ Removable bulkhead between cabins allows for transformation from 2 double berths to master suite
- ❸ Private head with shower for each cabin
- ❹ Fold-down extension ensures large bed and gives more space when standing
- ❺ Storage lockers under berths
- ❻ Hanging lockers and storage for each cabin

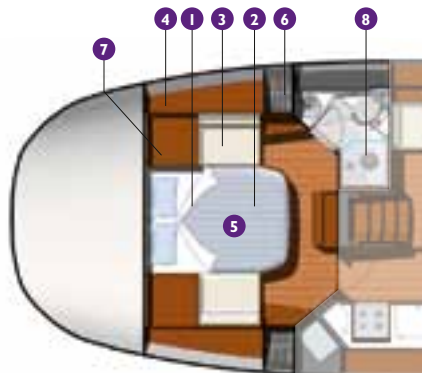
► 2 forward cabins



AFT CABIN: 2 VERSIONS

- ➊ Large island berth (2m x 1,5m) with PREMIUM mattress
- ➋ Headroom over the berth (92cm)
- ➌ Seating to either side of the berth with back rests
- ➍ Storage cabinets along the hull sides with indirect lighting underneath
- ➎ Dome under cockpit table provides headroom, light and ventilation
- ➏ Hanging lockers on each side
- ➐ Stylish reading lights
- ➑ Private head with shower compartment separated by plexiglass door

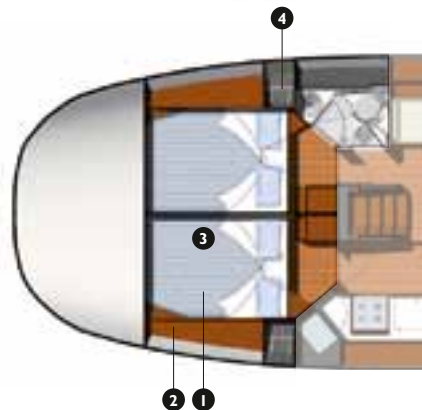
