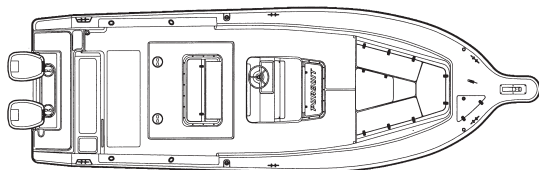


Pursuit 2870 Center Console; C 280

1997–2008



The 2870 Center Console (called the 2870 CC in 1997–2006; C 280 in 2007–08) is a rugged offshore fisherman with the built-in quality one expects in a Pursuit product. With a wide 9'6" beam, she delivers one of the larger fishing platforms in her class, and a generous fuel capacity gives her the long-range capability that big-water fishermen demand. Built on a deep-V hull with cored hullsides, the 2870's layout affords anglers the ability to fight fish from virtually anywhere on the boat. The tilt-away console is large enough to accommodate a good array of flush-mounted electronics and, like most center consoles in today's market, a fully enclosed head compartment with toilet, sink, and a pressurized water system is concealed within the console. The leaning post has a freshwater sink and tackle-storage space as well as a 35-gallon livewell, and the transom rigging station contains a large fish box, sink and raw water washdown. Additional features include a transom door, bow pulpit with anchor roller, an insulated in-deck fish box, a lockable electronics cover, and lockable bow storage. Twin 225hp Yamahas will reach a top speed of 40+ knots. Note that all-new Pursuit C 280 model was introduced in 2009.
