Notes

The immediate impression you have when first seeing the Sabre is the classic and smooth lines of the hull. Getting on board is very easy across the wide swim platform and through an inward swing door that is part of the transom construction rather than a stainless gate or plastic door. This extra touch adds again to the smooth lines of the boat because when the door is closed the transom is flush and no indentations are seen. The hinges and lock are stainless and they are very sturdy. Suffice to say, Sabre has really worked diligently to provide a timeless design in a boat that truly performs in most sea conditions.
