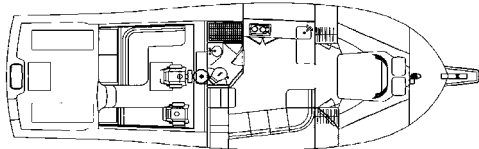
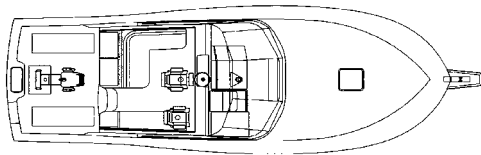


Cabo 40 Express

2003–Current



Widely regarded as one the best sportfish boats in her class, the Cabo 40 is a hardcore fishing machine from a company whose reputation for quality and performance is second to none. Built on a modified-V hull with deep propeller pockets and a well-flared bow, the Cabo 40 is a strikingly handsome boat whose muscular profile reflects her superb open-water performance. The 40's big 90-square-foot cockpit features a pair of in-deck fish boxes, a 45-gallon transom livewell, freezer, and a beefy transom door with top gate. The helm—a real piece of work—is on the centerline on the raised bridge deck where an L-shaped settee to port will accommodate several guests. Belowdecks, the 40's generous 15-foot, 9-inch beam is on full display in the wide-open salon with its warm teak joinerwork and plush furnishings. The starboard settee seats six and converts to upper/lower berths, and the large master stateroom is fitted with an island double berth and two hanging lockers. Additional features include single-lever controls, tremendous rod storage, hydraulic bridge deck lift, and 10KW generator. Cruise at 28–30 knots with 715hp Cats; low to mid 30s with 800hp MANs. Zeus pod drives became available in 2010.
