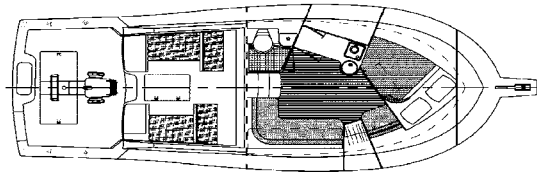


Cabo 32 Express

Experienced boaters and marine industry pros know that Cabo builds a great fishing boat. Starting with the Cabo 35 Flybridge in 1992, the company has introduced a series of high-end fishing machines designed for serious, hardcore anglers. The 32 Express—smallest model in the Cabo fleet—is a fast-action battlewagon with the premium amenities and features found in Cabo's larger boats. There's much to admire about the 32; she's one of the best-looking express boats her size to be found, and Cabo's obsessive attention to detail is on display in every nook and cranny. But it's the super-wide 13'3" beam that really sets the Cabo 32 apart from the competition. Indeed, she has a bigger cockpit, wider bridge deck, and more spacious interior than any boat in her class. A bait prep center, 45-gallon transom livewell, coaming pads, and large-capacity fish box are standard in the cockpit. The entire bridge deck sole lifts on hydraulic rams for engine access. Below decks, the Cabo's upscale (and surprisingly spacious) interior features a double berth forward, convertible dinette, and full service galley—comfortable accommodations for four. No lightweight, she'll cruise at 28 knots with 480 Yanmar diesels (30+ wide open).
