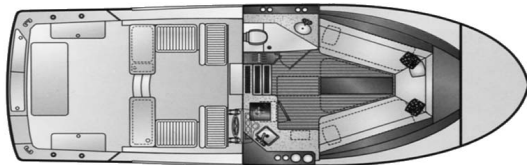


Luhrs 30/31 Open

The Luhrs 30 Open (called the Luhrs 31 Open in 2006-09) is one of a handful of inboard express fishing boats her size built in recent years. (Most fishboats in this size range are outboard-powered for reasons having to do with their higher speeds.) The 30/31 Open rides on a solid fiberglass deep-V hull whose prop pockets reduce both shaft angles and draft. The raised bridge deck offers excellent seating and helm visibility, and the cockpit is large enough to accommodate four anglers without bumping elbows. There are two insulated fish boxes in the cockpit, one in the sole and the other in the transom. A complete bait-prep center is forward, a cooler is to port, and a 45-gallon livewell is starboard. Below, the compact cabin is highlighted with a cherry-and-ash sole, quality hardware, and Corian counters. The forward settees convert to four single berths, and the head is quite large although it lacks an opening port. A hardtop, windlass, cockpit washdowns, and electronics box were standard. Standard gas inboards will cruise at 25 knots (low 30s top), and optional 315hp Yanmar diesels will cruise in the mid 20s (about 30 top). Newer models with Volvo 260hp IPS drives cruise at 22 knots.
