In fact the Toy 51 is born as a Lobster boat Design for daily outings and short cruises for demanding owners that are not satisfied with current industrial production yachts.

Naturally the guidelines are always given by the ideas of the Nauta Yachts Design team, that have worked for two years on the research for the interior and exterior design in order to recall the essential lines of the Toy 36 and at the same time withhold the immortal classic look of the real Lobster Boat. This gave birth to the Toy 51, a compromise between the present and the past, but with a look to the future. This boat, is actually at the Toy Marine boatyard in Savona and can be visited at your earliest convenience.
